Section 486. (This section applies to candidates at primary election.) Candidates to be voted for at primary election are required to render an accounting from the abovementioned date to the time for the holding of primary election, namely, September 24th, 1918. March 5th, 1918 - Any person who becomes a candidate for nomination for or election to any public office, without having publicly announced his candidacy more than eight months prior to the general election,...
