The mucosa of the anterior nares is raw and ulcerated; that of the posterior nares is thickened, yellowish, and in the early condition of sphacelus. No true membrane. Both tonsils are enlarged and gangrenous. Respiratory mucosa from larynx to bronchi is covered with a thick layer of sanio-mucopurulent fluid. The greater part of both lungs, which are of a dark purple hue, is consolidated, only their anterior and upper portions remaining crepitant; the pneumonia is a haemorrhagic broncho-pneumonia. The pleurae are dull all over, but there is no lymph. Mediastinal and submaxillary glands are large, soft, and purple. Heart 4 ozs., nil. Abdominal viscera febrile. Gastro-intestinal mucosa nil.
