An average of thirty-six putts per round of eighteen holes indicates satisfactory putting, though it is very hard in some cases to say whether certain strokes played from ten to twenty yards distance from the pin should be regarded as putts or chipshots; according to the rules of golf, the ground within twenty yards of the hole, excepting hazards, is to be regarded as the putting green, though the shot might have to be played with the mashie or the niblick.
