Such pupils are by no means uncommon; and, though they may attain to a mechanical proficiency on the pianoforte, all niceties of soundmodulation must be to them a matter of faith. To those, however, who possess a delicate ear, and take an interest in, as well as extract enjoyment from Music, we can recommend the perusal of Mr. Harris s little volume.
